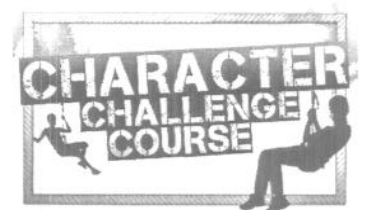


1. How do you define leadership?
